On behalf of Asian Counseling and Referral Service (ACRS), we thank you for your personal donation of \$1000 for the 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Walk for Rice. This year's walk drew more than 1,100 participants. Your generous gift, along with contributions from other donors and corporate sponsors, helped us raise more than \$107,219.82 for the ACRS Food Bank.

The ACRS Food Bank is the third most-used in King County and is the only one to provide Asian staples such as rice, ramen, tofu and Asian produce on a regular basis.
